NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the North Bergen Municipal Utilities Authority authorizes the Purchasing Agent to purchase certain goods or services from the approved New Jersey State Contract Vendor listed herein, pursuant to all conditions of the individual State contracts; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the governing body of the North Bergen Municipal Utilities Authority pursuant to N.J.A.C. 5:30-5.5(b), the certification of available funds, shall either certify the full maximum amount against the budget at the time the contract is awarded, or no contract amount shall be chargeable or certified until such time as the goods or services are ordered or otherwise called for prior to placing the order, and a certification of availability of funds is made by the Chief Finance Officer; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the duration of the contract between the North Bergen Municipal Utilities Authority and Gentilini Chevrolet LLC, 2703 Fire Road, Egg Harbor Township, New Jersey, 08234, for Chevrolet Vehicles (T-2776S); shall be from August 1, 2021 through December 31, 2021; and

# RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING EXECUTION OF AGREEMENT FOR A COOPERATIVE PRICING SYSTEM FOR PUBLIC NOTIFICATION OF CSOs AND FOR CSO DMRs (Year 2021)

WHEREAS, the North Bergen Municipal Utilities Authority (the "Authority") has the need for a public notification system to account combined sewer overflow ("CSO") events and to support monthly CSO Discharge Monitoring Reports ("DMRs"); and

WHEREAS, the Authority is a member of the New Jersey CSO Group (the "NJ CSO Group") led by the Passaic Valley Sewerage Commission ("PVSC"); and

**WHEREAS**, the NJ CSO Group's current Cooperative Pricing System for the Baseline Compliance Monitoring Program and Receiving Water Quality Model Development expires on December 15, 2021; and

WHEREAS, as a member of the NJ CSO Group, the Authority was included in the NJ CSO Group's CSO Notification System website (<a href="https://nicso.hdrgateway.com">https://nicso.hdrgateway.com</a>) (the "CSO Website"), which is utilized for permit required reporting and the preparation of monthly DMRs; and

**WHEREAS**, the Website is in need of updating and maintenance due to changes in sewer system models resulting from the preparation of the CSO Group's Long Term Control Plans; and

WHEREAS, this Board wishes to enter into an Agreement by and between the City of Paterson, the City of Newark, the City of Bayonne, the Passaic Valley Sewerage Commission, the Jersey City Municipal Utilities Authority, the Town of Harrison, the Town of Kearny, the Borough of East Newark, the City of Perth Amboy, the City of Elizabeth, the City of Hackensack, the Village of Ridgefield Park, the Town of Fort Lee, the Town of Guttenberg and the Authority (the "Members"), to establish a Cooperative Pricing System for the CSO Website update; and

WHEREAS, the cost share of the Authority for participation in the CSO Website update will not exceed \$13,420.14 of which \$5,004.80 is Guttenberg's share, which will be covered through Guttenberg's inter-local agreement with North Bergen; and

**WHEREAS**, in accordance with N.J.S.A. 5:30-5.4(a)(3), the Authority certifies the availability of funds to cover the maximum dollar value of the pending contract as set forth in the Resolution.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MEMBERS OF THE NORTH BERGEN MUNICIPAL UTILITIES AUTHORITY, that:

- 1. The aforesaid recitals are incorporated herein as though fully set forth at length.
- 2. The Authority's Executive Director, Authority Attorney or any other official, officer or employee of the Authority be and they are hereby authorized to execute any and all documents, including execution of the Agreement for a Cooperative Pricing System, and to take any and all actions necessary to complete and realize the intent and purpose of this Resolution.
