



Construction upgrades and improvements to the North Bergen Municipal Utilities Authority were financed by the New Jersey Infrastructure Bank (NJIB). The NJIB is a State Revolving Fund program jointly administered by the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection (NJDEP) and the New Jersey Infrastructure Bank (NJIB). It uses a combination of funds provided by the United States Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), the NJDEP, and the NJIB to provide very low interest loans to borrowers for environmental infrastructure projects.

This project will provide water quality benefits through the collection of combined sewer to reduce overflow into the waterways and avoid overloading the NBMUA treatment facilities.

State Revolving Fund programs around the nation provide states and communities the resources necessary to maintain and improve the infrastructure protecting our valuable water resources nationwide.
